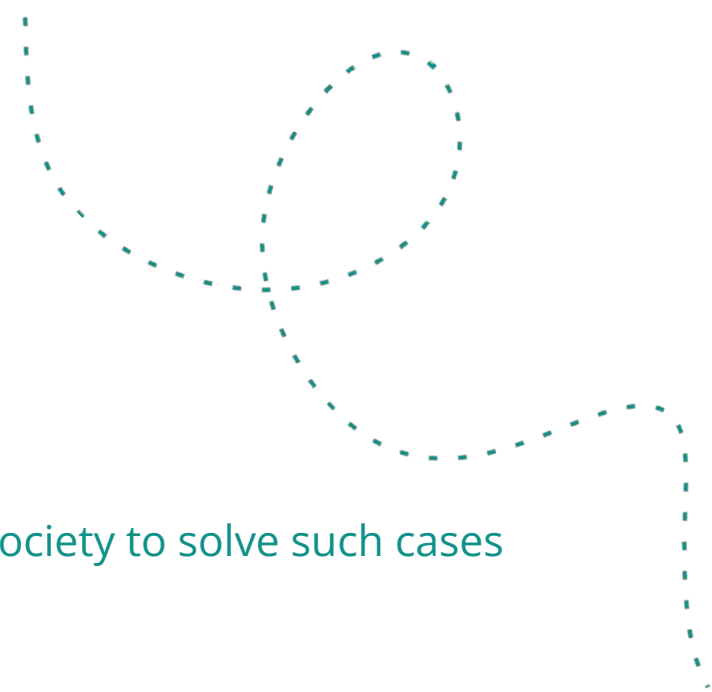

The main direction

- Solving cases of animal neglect and empowering society to solve such cases independently.
- Public education on animal welfare issues.

Additional activities

- Consultation of natural persons.
- Assistance to other organizations in consulting, organizing promotions, events, projects, preparing handouts, publicizing information.
- Participation in discussions of animal welfare laws, contributing to their preparation, in order to ensure that laws favorable not only to humans but also to animals are adopted.

ANIMAL NEGLECT CASES

We contribute to the application and enforcement of animal welfare and protection standards through legal means.

The annual campaign supports animal shelters with food and educates the public about homeless pet animals.

WHAT WAS DONE
IN 2020?



WORK DONE:

- We appeared **in the media 238 times**, educating on animal welfare topics.
- We have created an animal welfare group on Facebook platform, the purpose of which is to discuss cases and advise people and organizations publicly, thus teaching as many people as possible to provide assistance to animals independently.
- In the “neBrisius.lt” project, we photographed and told **62 stories**, of which 8 were about emigrating pets with their owners, **4** about animals with special needs | www.nebrisius.lt.
- We have prepared a **handbook** on how to distinguish illegal animal breeding sites from legal breeding farms.
- We worked with **74 cases of animal neglect and cruelty**, of which 32 animals’ living conditions were improved and/or the owner was punished in accordance with the procedure established by laws, in 25 cases there was a lack of evidence, as a result of which the cases were closed, and 17 cases are still being resolved.
- We have consulted **over 200 people** on animal welfare.

WORK DONE:

- We were included in the working group of the Ministry of Agriculture for the resolution of problematic issues of animal welfare control.
- We applied to the members of the Seimas with **arguments and proposals** regarding the legalization of prohibition of keeping animals for persons who have acted cruelly to animals.
- We have prepared a handbook on how to take care of pets if you get sick with **COVID-19**.
- We applied to the Government regarding the incompetence and indifference of the State Food and Veterinary Service in ignoring the long-standing problems of animal neglect in the country, in order to initiate fundamental changes in the subordinate institution.
- We have submitted **our proposals** for a project that aims to establish obvious criteria that will have to be followed by the SFVS inspectors during inspections of animal welfare and keeping conditions.
- We sent the Special Investigation Service material of cases in which justice could not be achieved precisely because of the reluctance of the State and Food Veterinary Service to contribute, and our suggestions were taken into account. **Learn about the SIS investigation.**

WORK DONE:

- We have launched a new long-term project of Laisvės TV and “Gyvūnų gerovės iniciatyvos” (GGI), which aims to systematically stop the illegal reproduction of animals and free animals from unjustified slavery.
- We have added 197 new places in Lithuania, which you can visit with pet animals, to the database of the project “Pet-Friendly”. 9 new ambassadors joined the project, who visited about 95 pet-friendly places during this year. | www.draugiskigyvunams.lt.
- We prepared the 2021 calendar of the “neBrisius.lt” project, which was decorated by shelter wards who could not find a new home for a long time.
- We have contacted over 600 educational institutions in order to stop the project „[Magiški kiaušiniai](#)“ that is becoming popular in them.

WORK DONE:

- We have prepared a report on what a clipped cat's ear means and when it is legal. We have contacted all shelters in Lithuania in order to stop the inappropriate use of such marking.
- We created an educational film "**Breeders vs Kennels**".
- We prepared a handbook about the "**Catch-Sterilize-Release**" programs implemented in different cities of Lithuania.
- We filled the database of frequently asked questions about animal welfare -> **FAQ**.
- We presented the Activity Report 2019

ORGANIZED:

- We organized the traditional support event “Show the pet a Christmas tree 2020”, as a result of which almost 2 tons of food (22,106 portions) were donated to shelters. Due to the quarantine, the event took place online. The sponsor of the event was “Mars Lietuva”, UAB.
- We organized the 8th birthday of GGI in Vingis Park, during which we invited pet owners to consult for free with specialists in 11 fields, to participate in lectures and sessions.
- We organized the event “Dog Day Test”, during which we not only gave out prizes, but also educated people on the topics of animal welfare.
